

Annual Vehicle Pass

An annual vehicle pass is available for the conservation areas in Central Lake Ontario Conservation's watershed. All pass proceeds assist with the maintenance of the conservation areas for your enjoyment.

The pass covers conservation area parking fees and general admission for a period of one year from date of issue. It does not include general admission to special events such as the Purple Woods Maple Syrup Festival.

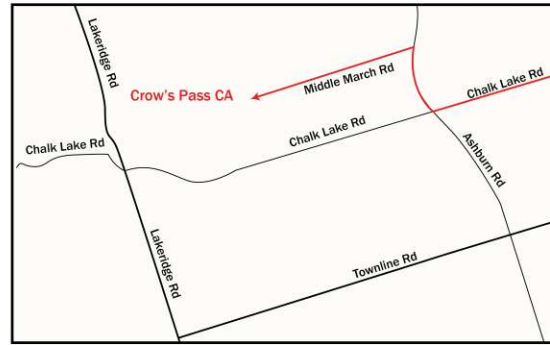

Take Highway 12 to Scugog Line 2 (Chalk Lake Road); turn west and travel to Ashburn Road. Turn north onto Ashburn Road and then turn west on Middle March Road. Continue west along unimproved road allowance to parking area. (Caution: watch for golfers where golf fairway crosses road allowance.)

Crow's Pass Conservation Area

Located on the top of the Oak Ridges Moraine, Crow's Pass Conservation Area is a favourite destination for the recreational hiker, offering 3km of forest floor trails along with a connection to the Oak Ridges Moraine Trail. Crow's Pass CA consists of 158 acres and was established in 2003 with the assistance of the Oak Ridges Moraine Foundation, Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and the Region of Durham. Classified as a Natural Core Area, it also includes several wetlands that are typically found in the rolling hills of the Oak Ridges Moraine. A great place to enjoy nature's fall colours!
